1. Boca Ciega Ballroom at the St. Pete Beach Community Center St. Pete Beach, FL

Located in the heart of St. Pete Beach on the beautiful Boca Ciega Bay, the center offers a plaza for ceremonies with a covered area under the building in case of rain. The second level ballroom features a covered outdoor patio and floor to ceiling windows facing the bay. Accommodates up to 200 guests. Our package includes additional rental chairs to supplement the 50 owned by the facility for outdoor use. Separate small rooms for getting ready.

2. St. Petersburg Garden Club

A hidden treasure for a garden wedding with indoor reception, the garden club has a convenient location just across the bay from Treasure Island and many resort hotels. Our package includes additional room decorating with white drapes and uplighting. Hold your ceremony in one of the many picture-perfect areas of property or under the large covered patio (that can also be used for social hour. Accommodates up to 200 guests. Separate bridal room.

3. St. Petersburg Women's Club <http://www.stpetersburgwomansclub.org/>
Located on Snell Isle, the club features a Mediterranean motif and ceremonies must be held outdoors on the back of the property. A spacious lawn and covered veranda areas can be used for social hours with main reception indoors. Accommodates up to 150 guests. Across the street from the bayou. Package includes outdoor rental chairs.

4. Clearwater Community Center – Clearwater Beach –

A popular wedding venue because of its intercoastal waterway location, the center is close to many popular Clearwater Beach hotels and resorts. Ceremonies are held on the lawn facing the water. Social hours can be hosted on the deck overlooking the main channel. The package includes decorating of the front entrance lobby and inside the main hall itself (sail curtains or palm trees with uplighting). Up to 175 guests can be accommodated. In case of inclement weather, ceremony would have to be held on the dance floor of the reception area.

5. Ferguson Law Center - Downtown Tampa

Situated on the campus of Stetson Law School, the center offers a uniquely upscale interior for ceremonies and receptions of up to 150 guests. Ceremonies can be held in the foyer with social hour in the fabulous wood inlaid bar area while chairs are being transferred into the main reception hall. The package does not include dance floor rental as the hall is carpeted. No outdoor ceremony space. Off-duty police officer required at an extra cost.

6. Firefighters Museum -Downtown Tampa

A two story historic building conveniently located just minutes off the I-275 North Downtown East exit. Plenty of free off-street parking. Indoor ceremonies only in the main ballroom on the second floor where guest tables are pre-set with ceremony chairs, aisle, and backdrop are on the dance floor area. Guests go downstairs to the main museum area for social hour while room is being reset for main reception. Lots of historical exhibits to keep guests entertained during picture taking. 12 Round 60-inch tables seating 8-10 guests with 8 long tables for head table, buffets, bars, and other seating. Accommodates up to 150 guests.

7. Tampa Woman's Club – South Tampa

A cozy venue with lots of natural light, the club is situated across Bayshore Boulevard from Tampa Bay. While smaller ceremonies can be performed on the front lawn, it is best to hold them in the combined parlor area. Up to 130 guests can be accommodated in the main room which features a small stage and grand piano. Package includes uplighted sail structures and other room décor such as tropical foliage.

8. Hollis Gardens & The Magnolia Building – Downtown Lakeland -

This fabulous location is often booked two years in advance because of its exquisite setting on Lake Mirror. Up to 10 chairs can be set in the garden for the ceremony or it can be held in the Amphitheater behind the Magnolia Building. Choice of rental chairs for the Amphitheater ceremony along with high top tables for the patio OR additional decorating inside room. Because the venue(s) must be paid in full when booking, the initial deposit for the TREASURE CHEST PACKAGE is higher. Up to 250 guests may be accommodated.

9. Sorosis Building (Junior League) - Lakeland

A great option for weddings of up to 120 guests. The rich dark wood and expansive windows create a beautiful backdrop – no need for additional décor. While smaller ceremonies can be hosted on the small lawn outdoors, the option to hold it in the main foyer is best. Main room has large stage. Package can include outdoor rental chairs, rental of round guest tables (only has long tables), or stage decorating. The place includes a two day rental. Across the street from Lake Morton.

10. South Florida Museum – Bradenton

A unique outdoor venue reminiscent of the early Spanish settlements of Florida. No access to main museum, but small weddings can be held in traditional chapel OR on the covered promenade. Main reception held on the plaza. In case of rain, there are enough covered areas around the plaza to accommodate all wedding activities. Maximum capacity is 200. Does not include use of air conditioned Boardroom. Package does include the rental of all tables and chairs which are not provided by the Museum. Boardroom is an extra \$500 and is perfect for bridal party preparations.
